## 2023 Fee Information

Cannon Hill Community Kindergarten is an approved kindergarten program provider under the Kindergarten Funding Scheme. Our program is delivered by a qualified Early Childhood Teacher for at least 15 hours a week for 40 weeks a year, and our Centre is rated “Exceeding National Quality Standards”.

Included in Kindy Fees are Membership/Affiliation fees, Incursions and activities, Storypark Manage enrolment portal and sunscreen.

### ADDITIONAL FEES AND LEVIES:

#### Enrolment Fee \$150 per child.

- Payable on confirmation of your child’s enrolment. This includes a Welcome Pack of two Kindy T-shirts, a bucket hat and library bag, and also covers the cost of your child’s yearly portfolio etc.

#### Parent Participation Levy - \$200 per family - *\*refundable at end of year\**

- As a community Kindy, we rely heavily on parent participation and support to assist in keeping our fees low. On completion of four volunteer tasks throughout the Kindy year, this Levy is fully refunded. Volunteer tasks include the mowing roster, volunteering for Bunnings Sausage Sizzle, Committee member etc.

### FAMILY TAX BENEFIT SUBSIDY ELIGIBILITY:

Family was eligible for the Australian Government's Family Tax Benefit Part A or Part B payment in the financial year prior to the kindergarten year (2021-22).

Proof must be provided as a letter from Centrelink with the heading "About your Family Tax Benefit 2021-22" – the family can access this from MyGov app.

### KINDY PLUS ELIGIBILITY:

- Hold a current Australian Government Health Care Card (HCC)
- Hold a current Australian Government Pensioner Concession Card (automatic HCC entitlements)
- Hold a Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card or White Card
- Have formal communication, such as a letter, from the relevant agency stating the intent to issue a Health Care Card
- Have evidence of formal foster or kinship care arrangements
- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Have three or more children, of the same age, enrolled in the same year
- Have a child who is identified as living in a formal child protection out-of-home care arrangement.
- The family and child have entered Australia under the Australian Government's Refugee and Humanitarian Program, or are in the process of seeking asylum in Australia and hold a temporary visa until their application for refugee status is determined.

Proof of eligibility is required for all categories, except for those identifying as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

For children who are attending the Service and are not eligible for the kindergarten funding to this Service please speak with the Office Manager for information relating to this.

Fees will be invoiced at the start of each term. Payment plans can be arranged if required.

It is a legislative requirement that children are signed and in out of the Service using the electronic Kiosk Portal. This is for the Kindergarten Funding Scheme purposes as well as ensuring that staff are aware that children are in attendance and have also been collected from the Service at the end of each day.
